Care for YOUR congregation

- **Provide Support:** Meals, shelter, emotional and spiritual care.
- **Identify Unmet Needs:** Stay connected with members to track ongoing needs and connect them with help.
- **Be an Advocate:** Speak up for those who may feel ignored or overwhelmed by recovery systems.
- **Amplify Their Voices:** Use your platform to share their stories and raise awareness in the wider community.

FEMA Can Help You While You Serve Others

- **EMERGENCY** repairs (eg Patching a roof)
- **PERMANENT** repairs (eg Replacing a roof)
- **Damages to facility** and parking lots resulting from providing critical services
- **Increasing Resilience or Access** to your building for future disasters

How Does It Work?

File with Insurance As Soon As Possible

Apply for a Small Business Administration Loan

- An SBA loan can help by providing funds immediately while your insurance company reviews policy and makes long term determination
- Loan accrues no interest in the first year.

FEMA may help pay for damages the loan doesn't cover
