



# THE FEMA PROCESS



## FIVE KEYS TO STAYING ON TRACK

**1**

### FEMA Timeline

- FEMA begins processing your application within 24 hours.
- Keep your FEMA application number in a safe place for updates and future assistance.



**2**

### Follow Up

- Receive updates via email or mail
- Monitor your disasterassistance.gov account
- You will receive a letter outlining approved aid or requesting more details.

**3**

### Home Inspection

- If a home inspection is needed, FEMA will call within 10 days using the number you provided.
- Be ready to show damage in person or virtually.



**4**

### Keep These On Hand:

- Receipts for all repairs
- Copies of your insurance settlement paperwork, if applicable.
- FEMA will request documentation

**5**

### You Have the Right to Appeal

- Simple typing errors may lead to a denial
- FEMA will explain reasons for denial
- Corrections are allowed and may overturn the denial notification
