




# GENERATOR SAFETY



Generator safety prevents deadly carbon monoxide poisoning, fires, and electrocution during power outages and emergencies.

## Keep generators outside

Running one inside or in a garage can cause deadly carbon monoxide buildup.



**02**

## Never refuel while running

Shut the generator off and let it cool to prevent fire or explosion.

**03**

## Plug into appliances, not outlets

Never backfeed a home outlet; it's dangerous and illegal without proper transfer switches.
