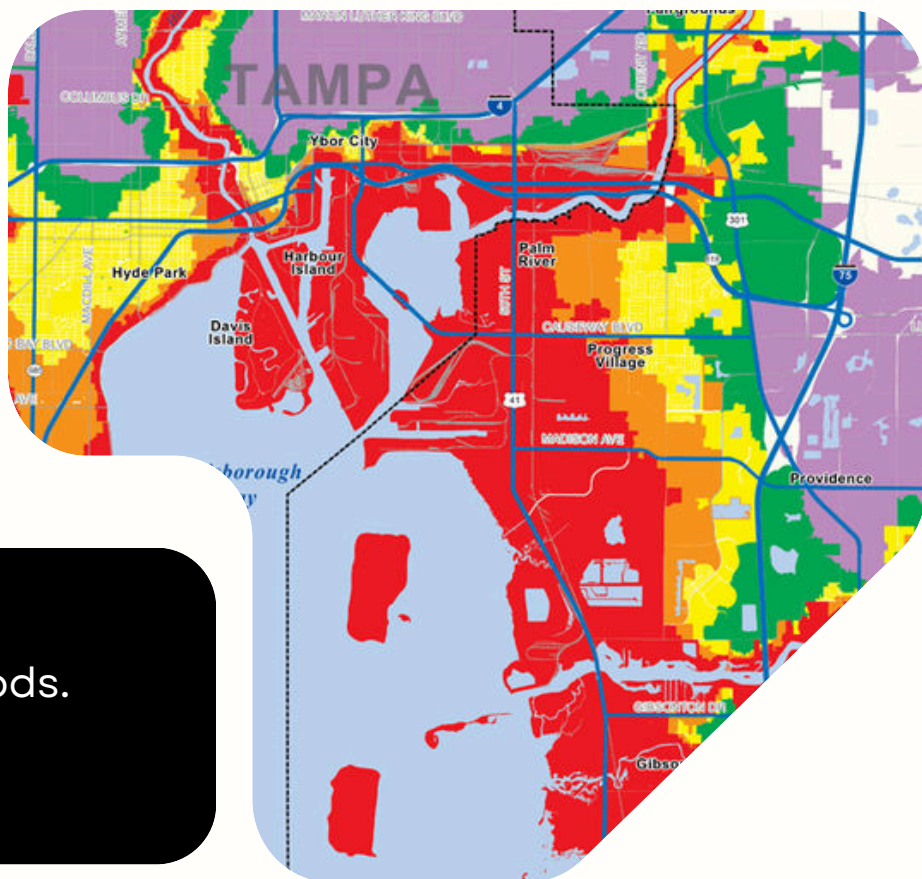




# KNOW YOUR ZONE

## 1 Why It Matters

- Zones are based on storm surge, not floods.
- Roads can become unsafe early.
- Waiting too long risks lives.

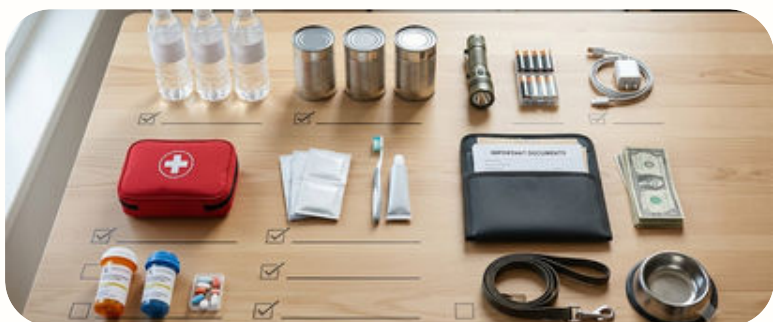


## 2 How to Find Your Zone

- Visit [FloridaDisaster.org/KnowYourZone](http://FloridaDisaster.org/KnowYourZone).
- Enter home, work, or school.
- Save your zone and route.

## 3 Evacuation Zone Guide

- Zone A/B: Highest risk; evacuate first.
- Zone C/D: Stay alert and ready.
- Zone E: Lower risk, still prepare.



## 4 What to Prepare

- Pack water, food, meds, documents, chargers.
- Plan for pets, family, transportation.
- Follow officials and evacuate early.

## 5 Stay Informed

- Monitor local emergency alerts closely daily.
- Charge phones before outages and storms.
- Share updates with family and neighbors.
